

Why the Auditor General Does Follow-Up Reports

- The Office of the Auditor General conducts audits to provide practical and constructive advice to improve government performance. The government has publicly said the agreed-upon timeframe to complete Auditor General recommendations is two years.
- If recommendations aren't completed, the same issues will persist. We encourage government, audit committees, and others responsible for oversight to continue addressing our recommendations and to publicly report on progress.
